Safety Committee Training Level 1

Under Manitoba Legislation, employers with 20 or more employees are required to have either a safety committee or a safety representative. To be effective in their role, they must be trained!

This course is designed to meet the learning requirements of Workplace Safety and Health Division – Level 1. Your committee member(s) or safety representative will receive practical skill sets, which will enable them to comply with provincial legislation and regulations.

Learning Objectives:

At the end of the workshop, participants will be able to:

- Identify their roles, responsibilities and duties through legislative review.
- Determine what is a hazard, properly assess a risk and to recommend appropriate control measures.
- Perform job hazard analysis.
- Understand and properly conduct workplace inspections.
- Perform incident investigations.
