Supervisors, lead or charge hands, foremen or team leaders need to understand their responsibilities in accordance with the legislation. Your Supervisors will receive practical skill sets, which will enable them to comply with provincial legislation and regulations.

Learning Objectives:

At the end of the workshop, participants will be able to:

- Identify their roles, responsibilities and duties through legislative review. Understand the internal responsibility system and due diligence.
- Determine what is a hazard, to properly assess a risk and to recommend appropriate control measures.
- Understand what a job hazard analysis is and how they are an fundamental part of the Workplace Safety Program.
- Discuss workplace inspections and conducting incident investigations.
