



QNET COVID-19 Protocols

For in person workshops in the QNET Training Room

Last updated August 31, 2020

QNET staff and facilitators are committed to providing quality programming while keeping your health and safety our top priority.

We are taking the following steps to help ensure the safety of everyone in the QNET office and training room:

All participants, facilitators and staff will need to self-screen the day prior to the workshop, and must also respond to screening questions before entering the training space. Anyone deemed at risk for COVID-19 will not be admitted.

Although masks are not mandatory, participants are encouraged to wear a face mask in the building, right until they enter the QNET training room. Masks are not required when seated physically distanced in the training room.

Hand sanitizer is provided and required to be used whenever entering the QNET office / training room, including after breaks or visits to the restroom. High touch surfaces (such as door knobs) will be sanitized regularly.

New in person class size limits (12-14 participants) allow each participant to have their own table, and tables are separated in the training room so that participants are 6 feet apart. Some items have been relocated and extra chairs removed to allow for additional space.

Air circulation in the training room has been improved with the assistance of our building maintenance team.

In an effort to minimize contact between participants, self-serve beverages and buffet food service will not be available. If food or beverages are provided, details will be outlined in the event confirmation prior to the session.
