



## QNET COVID-19 Protocols

For in person workshops in the QNET Training Room

Last updated September 15, 2020

QNET staff and facilitators are committed to providing quality programming while keeping your health and safety our top priority.

We are taking the following steps to help ensure the safety of everyone in the QNET office and training room:

All participants, facilitators and staff will need to self-screen the day prior to the workshop. Anyone deemed at risk for COVID-19 will not be admitted.

**UPDATE: Participants are asked to wear masks in the building (including the elevator and washroom) and in the QNET office or training space, unless they are seated and physically distanced.**

Hand sanitizer is provided and required to be used whenever entering the QNET office / training room, including after breaks or visits to the restroom. High touch surfaces (such as door knobs) will be sanitized regularly.

New in person class size limits allow each participant to have their own table, and tables are separated in the training room so that participants are 6 feet apart. Cabinets, chairs and other items have been relocated or removed to allow for additional spacing.

Air circulation in the training room has been improved with the assistance of our building maintenance team.

In an effort to minimize contact between participants, there will no longer be self-serve beverages or buffet food service. If food and beverages are provided, details will be outlined in the event confirmation prior to the session.
