



## **QNET COVID Protocols**

**For in person workshops in the QNET Training Room**

**Last updated September 15, 2021**

QNET Staff and facilitators are committed to providing quality programming while keeping your health and safety our top priority.

Participants, facilitators and staff must self-screen for signs of illness prior to the workshop. If you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or are self-isolating please stay home.

### **Participants are required to be fully vaccinated and show proof of vaccination**

Participants are required to wear masks in the QNET office and training room, unless they are seated and physically distanced in the training room. Mask wearing is also required in the building, including the elevators, restroom and corridors.

New in person class size limits allow each participant to have their own table and tables are separated in the training room so that participants are seated 6 ft apart.

Participants are reminded to practice social distancing at the event. There may be short instances when distancing is not possible; for example when walking by others on the way to the restroom.

Hand sanitizer is provided and required to be used whenever entering the QNET office / training room, including after breaks or visits to the restroom.

Air circulation in the training room has been improved with the assistance of our building maintenance team.

In an effort to minimize contact between participants, there will be no self-serve buffet food service. If food is provided, details will be outlined in the event confirmation prior to the session.

We remain committed to doing what we can to protect the health and safety of our participants. As new information about COVID-19 preventative best practices becomes available, QNET will evolve, expand and implement initiatives as needed.
