## Lean Six Sigma Information Session

This session will provide an overview of Lean Six Sigma, along with information on upcoming training opportunities here in Manitoba, including:

- **Yellow Belt Certification** (2.5 days + project + exam) – Learn the fundamental concepts of Lean and Six Sigma, problem solving methodology for Six Sigma and Lean, basic statistical concepts, the 7 Quality Control tools, and complete a “real” Yellow Belt project.
- **Green Belt Certification** (5 days + project + exam) – Learn the fundamental concepts of Lean Six Sigma improvement methodology and building-block tools, develop critical thinking, facilitation, coaching, presentation, and data analysis skills, get “real results” with a strategic Green Belt project.

If you are interested in learning more about Lean Six Sigma training or your organization is considering using Lean Six Sigma methodology, this session will provide you with information you need to make your decision.

**Facilitator: Vern Campbell** is a Consultant with Process Management LLC, a leading management consulting firm that specializes in the implementation of Lean Six Sigma within the framework of an integrated enterprise improvement system. He assists organizations with strategy development, deployment and continuous process improvement systems. From 2000 until 2011, Mr. Campbell was General Manager of Northern Blower, where he put his consultancy principles into practice working with Toyota Corporation to integrate Lean Six Sigma methods, the Toyota Production System, ISO 9000:2000 and Strategy Management into an overall Enterprise Improvement System. Mr. Campbell has a Six Sigma Black Belt from the University of Miami and he guest lectures at the University of Miami, School of Business and the Stern School of Business, New York University.
